



ANIMAL WELFARE POLICY

In Colombina, sustainability is conceived from its Business Objective, understanding that to be sustainable it is necessary to create transparent relationships of trust and mutual development with all stakeholders.

Colombina recognizes the importance of ensuring compliance with the principles of animal welfare throughout its value chain, which is why it motivates and commits its raw material suppliers to comply with these principles in their production chains and guarantee that they:


- Avoid conditions that generate hunger and thirst for animals, guaranteeing the availability of food and water.
- Provide comfort with an appropriate environment for their development.
- Facilitate care for pain, injury and illness, for prevention or diagnosis, and provide rapid treatment to animals.
- Generate freedom to express normal behavior, provide sufficient space, and facilities and appropriate company, according to each animal species.
- Ensure conditions and treatments that avoid the physical and mental suffering of animals.

Therefore, Colombina is committed to:

- By 2027, source exclusively cage-free eggs for all brands that use this ingredient in their production.
- Extend to all its suppliers of raw materials the importance of compliance with the Sustainability standards and its animal welfare policy.
- Promote training and sensitization of suppliers of raw materials to extend the recommended practices to their internal processes and their value chain.

During 2024, we made progress in reviewing formulas and seeking new suppliers to ensure an adequate supply of cage-free eggs, maintaining a 40% compliance rate with our goal. In 2025, we aim for 60% of the eggs used to be cage-free, reaffirming our commitment to a full transition by 2027.
