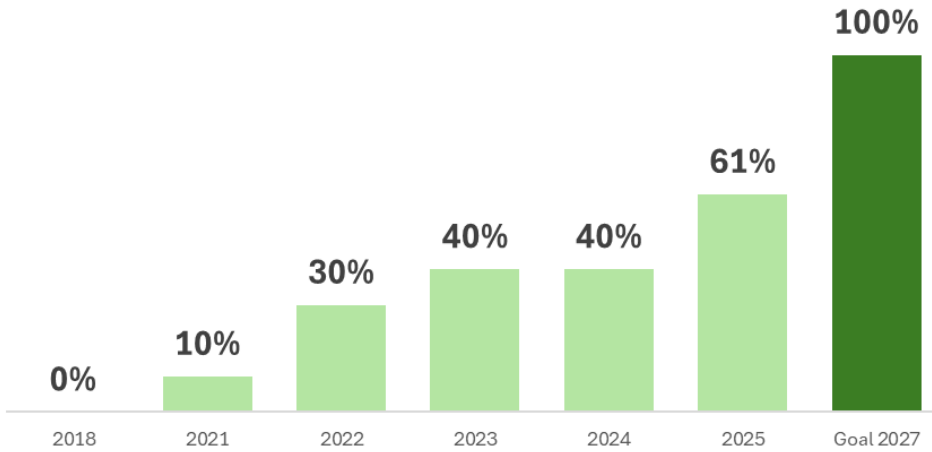
- Avoid conditions that cause hunger and thirst in animals by guaranteeing access to food and water.
- Provide comfort through an appropriate environment for animal development.
- Ensure attention to pain, injury, and disease through prevention or diagnosis, and provide prompt treatment to animals.
- Allow freedom to express normal behavior by providing sufficient space, as well as appropriate facilities and companionship according to each species.
- Ensure conditions and handling that prevent physical and mental suffering in animals.

Therefore, Colombina is committed to:

- By 2027, sourcing exclusively cage-free eggs for all proprietary brands that use this ingredient in their production.
- Extending to all suppliers of animal-derived raw materials the importance of complying with Sustainability standards and its Animal Welfare Policy.
- Promoting training and awareness among suppliers of animal-derived raw materials to extend recommended practices to their internal processes and value chain.

By 2025, 61% of the eggs used are cage-free, reaffirming our commitment to achieving full transition by 2027.
